



## How to Read a Plat Map



CHANGES "KEY"	
<b>BLK</b>	Full, three-digit page number area of map
<b>OLD</b>	The old (now changed) parcel number
<b>NEW</b>	The new (now changed) parcel number
<b>YR</b>	Assessed tax year the change took place
<b>CUT</b>	Refers to the Assessor's file for document number regarding the change

- 2 Parcel Number
- 3 Lot Number
- 4 Area of Lot
- 5 Approximate dimensions in Feet
- 6 Lot line (solid line)
- 7 Easement and Setback lines (dotted line)
- 8 Owner name as of the date of the map
- 9 Compass Indicator
- 10 Dropped parcel – indicates parcel has been canceled due to dedication to roadway.
- 11 Location of area
- 12 Plat Map number of neighboring area
